## VISITING SIGNUP PROCEDURES:

- Inmates will be allowed (1) half hour visit per week, with (2) visitors.
- Visitors are to call the Monroe Records at (530) 668-5245 to schedule their visiting time.
- Visiting signups will begin at 0700AM ending at Midnight the day before the visit. No advance scheduling is allowed. You cannot call on Monday to schedule a visit for Thursday.
- Once you have scheduled your visit you will not be allowed to change, re-schedule, or modify this appointment. Any cancelled visits will count against the inmate as a taken visit (no exceptions).

## Cut-off times for visiting signups will be as follows:

- Monday visits cut off Sunday at Midnight
- Tuesday visits cut off Monday at Midnight
- Wednesday visits cut off Tuesday at Midnight
- Thursday visits cut off Wednesday at Midnight
- Friday visits cut off Thursday at Midnight

## VISITING RULES

- Please arrive 30 minutes prior to your scheduled visiting time with a valid government issued ID. If you arrive late, your visit will be cancelled (no exceptions). All visitors must have a valid United States government issued photo ID or valid passport.
- You are allowed to bring in a single car key and your ID only. Nothing else will be permitted.
- Attire: No hats, sunglasses, or scarves. No sleeveless garments, short skirts/shorts, low cut shirts, or see-through clothing will be allowed. Please remember to dress appropriately.
- No gum, cigarettes, lighters, matches, tobacco, pagers, cellular phones, car alarms, key rings, purses, or briefcases will be permitted into the facility. The department will not be responsible for any lost, stolen, or misplaced property not allowed in this facility. Security of property will be the visitor's responsibility.
- No children under the age of 18 years are allowed to sit in the lobby or vehicles without proper adult supervision. If children cannot be controlled during visiting, the visit will be terminated.
- You must pass the metal detector in order to visit. Keep heavy jewelry to a minimum and no steel-toed shoes.
