(1) A summary of how the military equipment was used and the purpose of its use, October 1, 2022, through September 30, 2023.

UAS / DRONES

57 total drone deployments using a DJI Matric 300 RTK, DJI Enterprise Advanced, DJI Mini 2, and a DJI Mavic 3 Thermal. They were used for,

- 4- Crime scene photos
- 1- Overhead surveillance during large-scale eviction (DQU)
- 11- Attempt to locate and report suspicious subjects or wanted suspects
- 15- In progress crimes/emergency
- 11- Search Warrant
- 9- Search and Rescue / Missing Persons
- 2- Probation search
- 4- Assist Outside Agency.
 - Flood Control/inspection of the levee.
 - Cannabis task force.
 - CHP / search for outstanding suspects.
 - Woodland PD / search for stolen vehicle.

Yolo County Sheriff's Office SWAT Equipment

23 separate missions that involved the Yolo County Sheriff's Office. During those missions, the team used 10-33 gear on five separate occasions. The items used and what they were used for were,

- 5- 40 mm launcher deployments
- 5- NFDD (Noise Flash Distraction Device) deployments
- 3- Chemical agent deployments
- 2- Less lethal 40 mm foam round deployments

- 880 Tufts Court – Sheriff Operators used the 40 mm and deployed 40 mm foam projectiles to disable surveillance cameras. They also deployed a NFDD (Noise Flash Distraction Device) on the residence's exterior.
- 980 Central Street, Unit 314 – Sheriff Operators deployed an NFDD on the residence's exterior.
- 15850 County Road 50 - Sheriff Operators used the 40 mm and deployed 40 mm foam projectiles to breach a window where the suspect was barricaded. They also deployed an NFDD (Noise Flash Distraction Device) on the residence's exterior. Operators deployed a Tri-Chamber flameless chemical agent during the operation to gain compliance with the suspect.
- 3088 County Road 88C - Sheriff Operators used the 40 mm and deployed 40 mm ferret chemical agent rounds into the residence where the suspect was barricaded. They also deployed an NFDD (Noise Flash Distraction Device) on the residence's exterior.
- 2455 West Capitol Avenue, #159 - Sheriff Operators used the 40 mm and deployed 40 mm ferret chemical agent rounds into the suspect's barricaded residence.
