

Unidentified Persons

Coroner case #24-00309 Found 04/16/2024

An unidentified male was found deceased on a grassy trail behind a residence in West Sacramento. Death was attributed to natural causes.

Items recovered at the scene include:

- Short sleeve red polo shirt, women's size Large
- White metal bracelet on left wrist
- Cut off wrangler jeans, unknown size, near remains
- Taco Bell receipt for restaurant at 900 K Street, Sacramento

Physical Description

Older Asian male, 70-80 years old, 5'5" tall, weighing approximately 108 pounds with short grey hair and grey beard stubble. He was missing some teeth and had no fillings. Fingerprints and DNA submitted to the CA Department of Justice with no resulting matches. DNA profile uploaded to GEDmatch indicated an ethnicity of East Asian and Siberian which can be consistent with Northern Chinese. Video surveillance from the date of the Taco Bell receipt was located and showed an older male, possibly Asian, in line to order food. He was fully dressed and carrying property. Individuals at Taco Bell advised they had seen the male before and believed him to be homeless in the area, but they did not know his name. Multiple press releases and image releases have been published without any additional leads being developed.
